VietJet began flight operations in December 2011. VietJet has orders for more than 100 new A-320 family aircraft. VietJet currently operates 56 A-320/321 aircraft and is continually adding aircraft.

Currently, the airline operates a route network covering destinations nationwide and more than 30 regional destinations in Thailand, Singapore, South Korea, Taiwan, Malaysia, China, Japan, Hong Kong and Myanmar. It is operating a fleet of A320s and A321s with average age of 3.3 years.

Contract Term:	12 Months Renewable
Domicile:	Hanoi or Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam
Days Off:	Non Commuting: 8 Days Off per Month Commuting: 6 Weeks ON / 2 Weeks OFF
Travel Benefits:	Free Travel on Airline Network for Pilot and Immediate Family.
Ground Transportation:	VietJet Air shall provide transportation for Pilot away from the Base and between airports and hotels in performance of flight operation duties.
Accommodations:	VietJet Air shall provide Pilot with housing accommodations upon Pilot's passing of the CAAV Medical Check in Vietnam for up to ten (10) days regardless of whether Pilot successfully completes and passes their Vietnamese Certification Simulator Check-ride. Upon receiving their Vietnamese Civil Aviation Airman Certification, Pilot shall be responsible to pay for their own accommodations and transportation in Ho Chi Minh City.
