Air Japan is a wholly owned subsidiary of All Nippon Airways (ANA) and operates as an extension of ANA. ANA is a premier International Airline with a 5-Star rating from Skytrax and a superb safety record. Air Japan is staffed with ANA supervisors, check airmen and instructors. training is done at the Tokyo ANA training facility and the flights are operated under ANA dispatch and operations control. AJX is a very professional and well organized airline.

Air Japan uses the All Nippon call sign on all flights except the Seoul Incheon and Narita-Honolulu routes, which use the Air Japan call sign. Air Japan serves routes within Japan and internationally from Japan to China, South Korea, Singapore, Taiwan, Thailand, the United States, and Vietnam (as of September 2013).
