

## ABOUT BAMBOO AIRWAYS



The skies in Vietnam just got a little more crowded! Vietnamese start-up airline Bamboo Airways has received an air operator certificate (AOC) from the Civil Aviation Authority of Vietnam (CAAV) and is in need of qualified A320 Captains and First Officers.

In November, Bamboo Airways was granted an aviation licence by the CAAV, which allowed the airline to lease its first few airplanes. This new AOC will now enable Bamboo to operate commercial flights and become the fifth passenger airline in Vietnam.

The carrier plans to launch 37 routes in 2019. Apart from domestic flights, Bamboo says it will fly to Japan, Korea and Singapore, with further international destinations coming soon.

Bamboo Airways is owned by Vietnamese property investment and construction company FLC Group. In 2018, the start-up signed order intentions for 24 Airbus A320neo and 20 Boeing 787-9 Dreamliners.<sup>1</sup> The current projection for the fleet is 100 aircraft by 2022.

## INTERVIEW AND TRAINING PROCESS

### Initial Screening:

Initial Screening will consist of two parts:

- **Online Theory Exam:** This is an online “Open Book” Exam and will entail Aviation Theory Subjects in addition to B787 questions.
- **Skype Interview:** This Skype Interview will be administered by Bamboo Airways HR and Flight Operations Personnel. Be prepared to answer questions concerning
  - B787 Drills (Memory Actions)
  - B787 Limitations
  - B787 General Systems Knowledge
  - CRM

### Training Pay:<sup>3</sup>

Training Pay will consist of the following:

- After arriving in Hanoi, you will begin to accrue 50% Salary.
- After finishing training and passing the OPC, you will receive the withheld 50% salary as a one-time payment in addition to starting to receive regular 100 % pay.
- Pilots will be responsible for accommodations in Hanoi while in Training. Paramount has personnel on the ground in Hanoi who will assist you in securing accommodations in Hanoi.
- Accommodations for Training outside of Hanoi will be provided by Bamboo Airways.

### Training Footprint:

**Ground and Simulator Training** will last from 20 to 34 days and will consist of the following:

- Arrival in Hanoi **3 days** prior to the Medical Check
- Medical Check
- Ground School (during this period the results of the Medical Check will be published. This may take 3 to 5 days.)
- B787 Recurrent Training is around **11 days**
- OPC takes around **3-5 days** to accomplish
- A down time of **3 to 15 days** for CAAV License Issuance.

### Flight / Line Training

- 10 sectors of Initial Operating Experience prior to release to line.

### Training Locations

- Ground Training in Hanoi
- Simulator Training in Ho Chi Minh City or Singapore
- Wet Drills in TBD

## **ADDENDUM FOR PAY DURING AIRLINE AOC APPROVAL**

### **AOC not Granted during the 1st Three Months of Employment:**

In case Bamboo Airways has not been granted the AOC for the B787, Bamboo Airways guarantees to pay 100% of the monthly salary to the pilot as follows:

- 1st Month: 75% of monthly salary.
- 2nd Month: 85% of monthly salary.
- 3rd Month: 100% of monthly salary + the remaining amount of the 1st and 2nd month salaries (25% and 15% respectively).

### **AOC Granted during the 1st Two Months of Employment:**

- If the Bamboo Airways is granted the AOC at any time during the first two months, Bamboo Airways will pay the pilot the actual prorated salary according to the percentage applied for the month until the starting date of training course.
- From the training course date, salary will be paid out as outlined in the Training Pay Section of this Contract Overview. The balance of these two periods will be paid to Crew member when he/she passes the Simulator Check and OPC.
